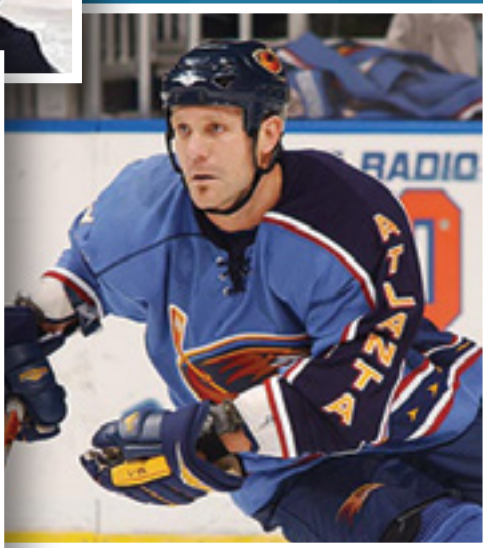

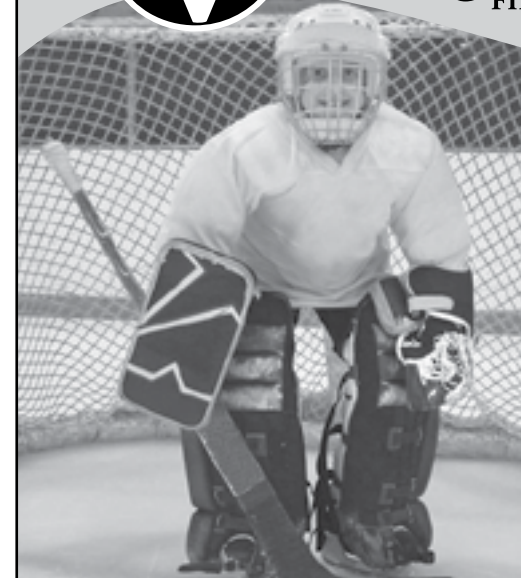

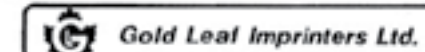

Crowchild's Pee Wee Blackhawks battle annually for top spot in the Hockey Calgary Pee Wee 1 Division. This division, which they currently lead, is compiled of the 12 most elite pee wee teams from over 120 teams playing out of 19 Associations within Calgary.

The NAHA Grizzlies have seven teams with the Pee Wee A's being the first team formed under this association. The majority of these players started as Grizzlies Mites and have gone through the ranks of Mite, Squirts and now Pee Wee A's as Grizzlies.

The NAHA Grizzlies Head Coach is Dave Teets and the Assistant Coach is Bruce Laiti. The team has fifteen players with five first year Pee Wee's, and 10 second years. The NAHA Grizzlies play in the Alaska League. This year, there are three teams in the Pee Wee Tier I division. At the time of this writing the NAHA Grizzlies have not started league play. Last year the team finished fifth in the Alaska League as Pee Wee B's. The NAHA Grizzlies will host the Alaska State Tournament to be held in March 2007 in Fairbanks, Alaska.

The Langley Eagles have been champions two of the three tournaments they have competed in so far this season and have proven to be one of the top teams in the province. They won the KMHA Tournament in October which included five consecutive wins versus Kamloops, Prince George, Fort St. John, Vernon and Semiahmoo. They were also champions of Langley's Gil Martin tournament in November having gone undefeated against Penticton, Kelowna, Surrey, Victoria Racquet Club and North Shore Winter Club. The Eagles are also participating in the 2007 Bell Capital Cup in Ottawa December 28th to January 1st with teams from all areas of the world.

The Langley Eagles play in the Pacific Coast Tier 1 division consisting of the nine top teams in the Lower Mainland where the team is very competitive, currently undefeated in league play. The Eagles have built the team around skill, and work hard with strong beliefs in commitment and discipline to continuously improve. 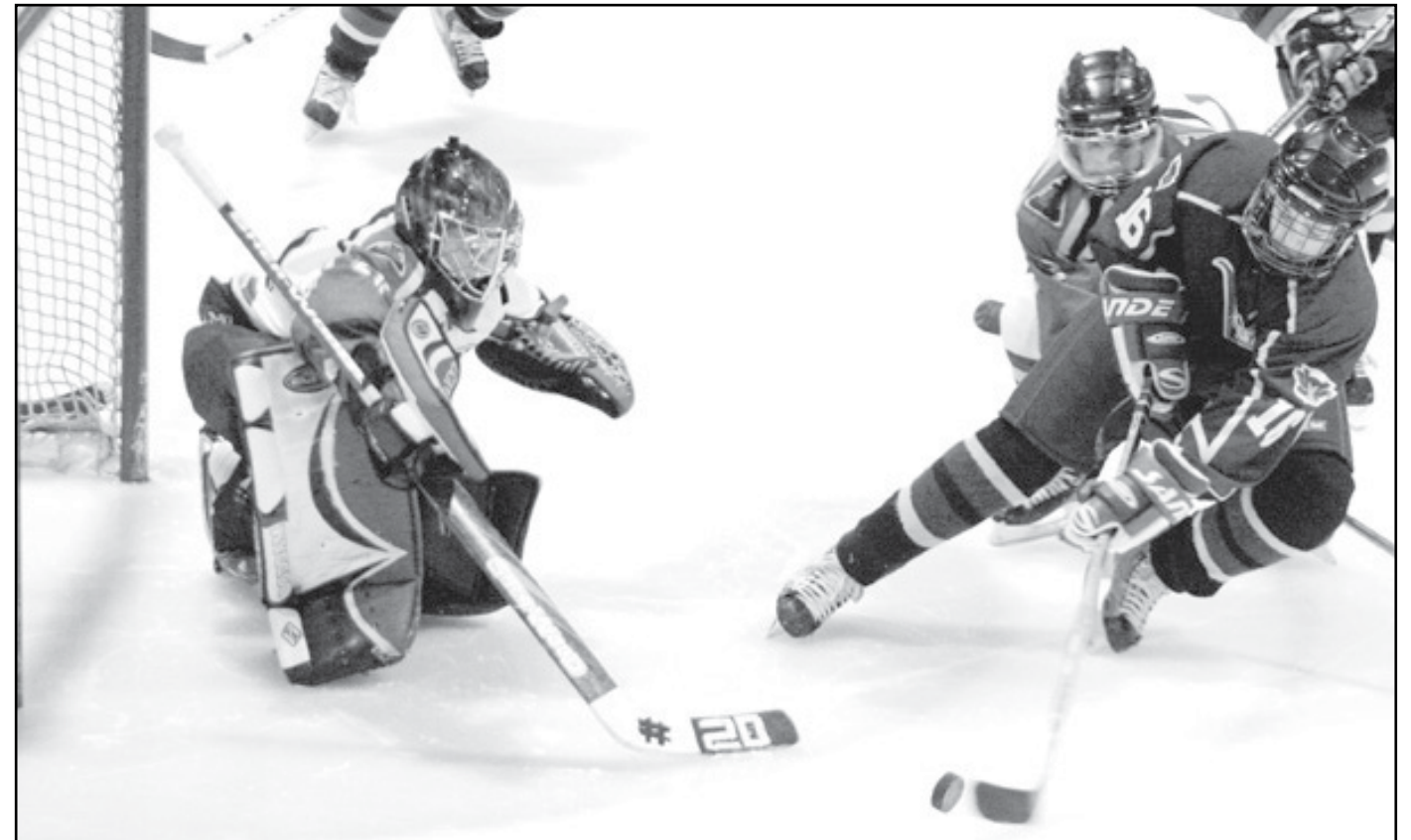

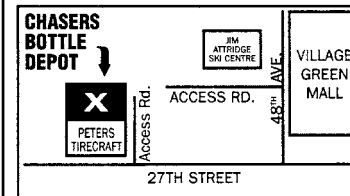
